

**CITY OF OKOBOJI  
SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING  
TUESDAY, MARCH 25, 2014, 5:30 P.M.**

**After the Pledge of Allegiance, Mayor VanderWoude called the meeting to order at 5:30 P.M.**

Mendenhall/Andres moved to adopt the agenda. All ayes. Motion carried.

**Council to consider changing the date of the regularly scheduled April council meeting:** Robinson/Andres moved to approve changing the regularly scheduled April 8, 2014, meeting to April 15, 2014. All ayes. Motion carried.

**Council to consider the lease/purchase of a new city car:** Councilmember Robinson spoke to the Council concerning the condition of the now owned 2005 Chevrolet Impala that City Administrator Dennis Daly is provided. Robinson continued by saying the current vehicle has a large number of miles on it now, and is approaching the point that repairs are going to be expensive and pointless. Motor Inn of Spirit Lake, Iowa, was first approached producing a trade-in of over \$9000.00 for a 2012 Impala that already has 60,000 miles on it. Robinson stated Okoboji Motors of Spirit Lake, Iowa, was approached, and they proposed a lease of a new 2013 Toyota Camry for \$229.00 per month for three years/36,000 miles. Robinson recommended the City enter into the lease with Okoboji Motors. After discussion, Delperdang/Mendenhall moved to approve the lease of a 2013 Toyota Camry at \$229.00 per month for a three-year lease. All ayes. Motion carried.

**Council to consider a closed session to discuss and review a potential new City Attorney appointee per Chapter 21.5 (1) (i) of the Code of Iowa:** Andres/Robinson moved to go into closed session to discuss and review a potential new city attorney. All ayes. Motion carried. Closed session began at 5:41 P.M. Robinson/Hentges moved to come out of closed session and reconvene in open session. All ayes. Motion carried. Open session reconvened at 6:30 P.M.

**Council to consider an appointment for City Attorney:** Andres/Robinson moved to appoint Dave Stein, Jr. of the Stein Law Office as the City Attorney for the City of Okoboji. AYES: Delperdang, Andres, Robinson. NAYS: Hentges, Mendenhall. With the vote being 3-2 in favor of the appointment, the Mayor declared the motion duly carried.

Robinson/Andres moved to adjourn. All ayes. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 6:32 P.M.
