



## CHAPTER 65

**65.01 THROUGH STREETS - STOP.** Every driver of a vehicle shall stop, unless a yield is permitted by this chapter, before entering an intersection with the following designated through streets.

*(Code of Iowa, Sec. 321.345)*

1. Lakeshore Drive;
2. Highway 71.

**65.02 STOP REQUIRED.** Every driver of a vehicle shall stop in accordance with the following:

*(Code of Iowa, Sec. 321.345)*

1. Exchange Street. Vehicles traveling south on Exchange Street shall stop at Stakeout Road;
2. Chalstrom Circle. Vehicles traveling west on Chalstrom Circle shall stop at Stakeout Road;
3. Chalstrom Beach Road. Vehicles traveling west on Chalstrom Beach Road shall stop at Stakeout Road;
4. Dixon Street. Vehicles traveling west on Dixon Street shall stop at Fairfield Street;
5. Julia Street. Vehicles traveling north on Julia Street shall stop at Sanborn Avenue;
6. Julia Street. Vehicles traveling south on Julia Street shall stop at Depot Avenue;
7. Country Club Drive (west entrance). Vehicles traveling south on Country Club Drive (west entrance) shall stop at Sanborn Avenue;
8. Country Club Drive (east entrance). Vehicles traveling south on Country Club Drive (east entrance) shall stop at Sanborn Avenue;
9. Eloise Street. Vehicles traveling north on Eloise Street shall stop at Sanborn Avenue;
10. Eloise Street. Vehicles traveling east on Eloise Street shall stop at Julia Street;
11. Okoboji View Avenue. Vehicles traveling west on Okoboji View Avenue shall stop at Exchange Street;
12. Lakeshore Drive. Vehicles traveling west on Lakeshore Drive shall stop at Sanborn Avenue.

**65.03 THREE-WAY STOP INTERSECTIONS.** Every driver of a vehicle shall stop before entering the following designated four-way stop intersections:

*(Code of Iowa, Sec. 321.345)*

1. Intersection of Echo Bay Avenue and Nichols Avenue. Vehicles approaching the intersection of Echo Bay Avenue and Nichols Avenue from the north, south and east shall stop before entering such intersection.
2. Intersection of Hollingsworth Street and Nichols Avenue. Vehicles approaching the intersection of Hollingsworth Street and Nichols Avenue from the north, south and east shall stop before entering such intersection.
3. Intersection of Park View Avenue and Nichols Avenue. Vehicles approaching the intersection of Park View Avenue and Nichols Avenue from the north, south and east shall stop before entering such intersection.
4. Intersection of Lakeshore Drive and County Home Road. Vehicles approaching Lakeshore drive and County Home Road from the north, south, or east shall stop before entering such intersection.
5. Intersection of Fairfield Street and Lakeshore Drive. Vehicles approaching Fairfield Street and Lakeshore Drive from the north, south, or east shall stop before entering such intersection.

**65.04 YIELD REQUIRED.** Every driver of a vehicle shall yield in accordance with the following:

**65.05 STOP BEFORE CROSSING SIDEWALK.** The driver of a vehicle emerging from a private roadway, alley, driveway, or building shall stop such vehicle immediately prior to driving onto the sidewalk area and thereafter shall proceed into the sidewalk area only when able to do so without danger to pedestrian traffic and shall yield the right-of-way to any vehicular traffic on the street into which the vehicle is entering.

**65.06 STOP WHEN TRAFFIC IS OBSTRUCTED.** Notwithstanding any traffic control signal indication to proceed, no driver shall enter an intersection or a marked crosswalk unless there is sufficient space on the other side of the intersection or crosswalk to accommodate the vehicle.

**65.07 YIELD TO PEDESTRIANS IN CROSSWALKS.** Where traffic control signals are not in place or in operation, the driver of a vehicle shall yield the right-of-way, slowing down or stopping, if need be, to yield to a pedestrian crossing the roadway within any marked crosswalk or within any unmarked crosswalk at an intersection.
