**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON AN ORDINANCE AMENDMENT TO ADD A
NEW CHAPTER 152 – “DRAINAGE LIMITATIONS” PERTAINING TO DISCHARGE
OF STORM WATER ONTO CITY STREETS AND RIGHT OF WAYS**

Public Notice is hereby given that the City of Okoboji, Iowa (“CITY”) proposes to add Chapter 152, “DRAINAGE LIMITATIONS”:

Amend/replace/add new language:

152.01 DRAINAGE ONTO CURBS OR STREETS

No footing drain, storm water drain, sump pump outlet, or drainage tile shall be constructed as to discharge water directly into a city street curb. The discharge such that water issuing from them shall be dispensed entirely upon the grounds of the contributing property and all such outlets shall be located not less than fifteen feet from the curb of a city street or the edge of a traveled way, or at a point not less than one-half the distance from the edge of the building foundation to such curb or edge of traveled way, which distance is smaller. However, this section shall not apply to properties located in the C-1 General Commercial zoning district where such properties are so situated that compliance with this section is not feasible due to the construction of buildings on the property immediately adjacent to city curbs or sidewalks.

152.02 RULES

The Council may provide by resolution such further rules as necessary to clarify and implement the requirements of this chapter.

152.03 VIOLATIONS

A violation of this chapter, or the omission or failure to perform any act or duty required to comply with this chapter, is a municipal infraction and punishable by civil penalty, all as set forth in Chapter 3 of this Code of Ordinances.

The City Council will hold a public hearing on the 11th day of August, 2020 at the hour of 6:00 PM at the Pearson Lakes Art Center (2201 Hwy 71, Okoboji, Iowa) in Okoboji, Iowa. The terms and conditions of this amended/replaced language will be discussed/reviewed/changed and determined by the City and its Council at said meeting, and may be modified at the public hearing. Following said hearing, the Council may take action.
