NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING FOR LAKESHORE LANDSCAPING

Notice is hereby given that the Planning and Zoning Commission for the City of Okoboji, Iowa will conduct a public hearing on Monday, September 28, 2020 at 5:30 PM via Zoom Teleconference to consider an application for Lakeshore Landscaping permit submitted by the Iowa Department of Natural Resources and the City of Okoboji, owners of Lots 1-7, and Adjacent Rail Road, Plat of Morningside, City of Okoboji, Dickinson County, Iowa AND Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6 Block B, and Adjacent Rail Road, Subdivision of Blocks I, L, J, and K, Beck's Replat of Okoboji City. This property is otherwise known as Hattie Elston State Park and East Lake Park.

The Iowa Department of Natural Resources and the City of Okoboji are requesting a lakeshore landscaping permit in accordance with the City of Okoboji's Landscaping of Lakeshore Property ordinance which under Article XII, Section 4.D requires notifications of all property owners within 200' of the subject property.

Please contact the City Administrator if you have any questions, comments, or concerns about this project.

Any party of interest may appear at the hearing or by legal counsel to express their views either in support of or against the granting of the lakeshore landscaping permit. Written comments shall be delivered or mailed to the office of the City Administrator no later than 4:00pm on the above date.

PLEASE NOTE: Pursuant to Iowa Code Section 21.8, an electronic Planning and Zoning Commission meeting may be held because a meeting in-person is impossible or impractical due to concerns for the health and safety of Commission members, staff, and the public presented by COVID-19.
