

ORDINANCE NO. 257

ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF OKOBOJI, IOWA, BY ADDING NEW LANGUAGE TO CHAPTER 69 IN “NO PARKING ZONES” DESIGNATING LAKESHORE DRIVE TO BE NO PARKING ON THE ODD ADDRESSED SIDE OF THE ROAD FROM THE INTERSECTION OF GIVENS STREET AND LAKESHORE DRIVE TO PIKES POINT STATE PARK AND BY ADDING CHAPTER 69.12 “FINES”

WHEREAS, the Council (“Council”) of the City of Okoboji, Dickinson County, Iowa (“City”) is considering an amendment to the ‘No Parking Zones’ ordinance;

WHEREAS, the City is considering adding new language to now establish the odd addressed side of Lakeshore Drive to be a no parking zoning from the intersection of Givens Street and Lakeshore Drive to Pikes Point State Park;

WHEREAS, the City is considering adding new language to now establish fines for violation of this chapter of the City of Okoboji Municipal Code;

BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Okoboji, Iowa:

SECTION 1. The Code of Ordinances of the City of Okoboji, Iowa, Section 69.08 is hereby amended by adding subsection 16 and the following:

16. Odd addressed side of Lakeshore Drive from the intersection of Givens Street and Lakeshore Drive to Pikes Point State Park.

Section 2. The Code of Ordinances of the City of Okoboji, Iowa, Section 69.12 is hereby added as follows:

69.12 FINES

1. Violations of this chapter shall be considered parking violations under Section 321.236 of the Iowa Code. The fine shall be fifty (\$50.00). The fine does not include any towing charges or vehicle storage fees if applicable.
2. Violations of this chapter may be charged and fines collected upon a simple notice of fine. The fine shall be payable to the City and shall be paid at the Okoboji City Hall, 1322 Hwy 71 N., Okoboji, Iowa.
3. The “notice of fine” shall be placed on a conspicuous place owner or operator of the vehicle if that person is available.
4. If the “notice of fine” is denied or not paid, violations of this chapter may be prosecuted by the compliant or uniform citation pursuant to the provisions of Section 805.07 to 805.13, inclusive of the Iowa Code as any other traffic violation.

SECTION 3. REPEALER. All Ordinances or part of Ordinance in conflict with the provision of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any Section, provision or part of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole or any Section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 5. PUBLICATION. The City Clerk/Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to publish this Ordinance in a newspaper of general circulation in Dickinson County, Iowa in conformance with the Iowa law.

WHEREAS, a motion was made on August 11, 2020 by Councilmember Mendenhall and a second by Councilmember Andres to consider the first reading of this Ordinance and upon roll call the following vote was recorded: AYES:

Delperdang, Hentges, Robinson, Mendenhall, Andres. NAYS: None. Said motion to consider this Ordinance was approved by the City Council.


WHEREAS, a motion was made on September 9, 2020 by Councilmember Robinson and a second by Councilmember Mendenhall to consider this on its second reading and upon roll call the following vote was recorded: AYES: Andres, Delperdang, Mendenhall, Robinson. NAYS: None. Said motion to consider this Ordinance was approved by the City Council.

WHEREAS, a motion was made on October 13, 2020 by Councilmember Hentges and a second by Councilmember Delperdang to consider this on its third reading and upon roll call the following vote was recorded: AYES: Andres, Delperdang, Hentges, Robinson, Mendenhall NAYS: None. Said motion to consider this Ordinance was approved by the City Council.

WHEREAS, a motion was made on October 13, 2020 by Councilmember Hentges and a second by Councilmember Robinson to adopt this Ordinance and upon roll call the following vote was recorded: Andres, Delperdang, Hentges, Robinson, Mendenhall NAYS: None. Said motion to adopt this Ordinance was approved by the City Council. Thereupon, the Mayor declared this Ordinance, passed and approved on the date shown below.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Okoboji, Iowa:
