

ORDINANCE NO. 262

ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF OKOBOJI, IOWA, BY ADDING NEW LANGUAGE IN SECTION 63.04 "SPECIAL SPEED ZONES" DESIGNATING 165TH STREET FROM THE INTERSECTION OF CENTER LAKE DRIVE TO HAVE A 25 MPH SPEED LIMIT.

WHEREAS, the Council ("Council") of the City of Okoboji, Dickinson County, Iowa ("CITY") is considering an amendment to the "Special Speed Zones" ordinance;

WHEREAS, the City is considering adding new language to now require 165th Street have a 25 MPH speed limit between the intersection of Center Lake Drive and the City's jurisdiction of 165th Street;

BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Okoboji, Iowa:

SECTION 1. The Code of Ordinances of the City of Okoboji, Iowa, Section 63.04 under subsection 1 (Special 25 MPH Speed Zones) and under point B is hereby amended by adding the following:

C. 165th Street between the intersection of Center Lake Drive and the City's municipal boundaries on 165th Street.

SECTION 2. REPEALER. All Ordinances or part of Ordinances in conflict with the provision of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any Section, provision or part of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole or any Section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 4. PUBLICATION. The City Clerk/Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to publish this Ordinance in a newspaper of general circulation in Dickinson County, Iowa in conformance with the Iowa law.

WHEREAS, a motion was made on October 13, 2020 by Councilmember Andres and seconded by Councilmember Robinson to consider this Ordinance and upon roll call the following vote was recorded: AYES: Andres, Delperdang, Robinson, Mendenhall, Hentges NAYS: None. Said motion to consider this Ordinance was approved by the City Council;

WHEREAS, a motion was made on October 13, 2020 by Councilmember Delperdang and seconded by Councilmember Robinson to waive the second and third considerations of this Ordinance and upon roll call the following vote was recorded: AYES: Andres, Delperdang, Hentges, Mendenhall, Robinson. NAYS: None. Said motion to waive the second and third considerations of this Ordinance was approved by the City Council, and therefore, the second and third considerations of this Ordinance were waived;

WHEREAS, a motion was made on October 13, 2020 by Councilmember Hentges and seconded by Robinson to adopt this Ordinance and upon roll call the following vote was recorded: AYES: Andres, Delperdang, Hentges, Mendenhall, Robinson. NAYS: None. Said motion to adopt this Ordinance was approved by the City Council. Thereupon, the Mayor declared this Ordinance, passed and approved on the date shown below;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Okoboji, Iowa:
